## Nomination Criteria for Commonwealth Games, Glasgow 2014

The process of establishing Nominees for selection consideration for the Men's and Women's Prone, 3x20 and 3x40 cartridge disciplines at the Glasgow 2014 is due to commence.

The following criteria will be used as consideration when nominees' names are finally submitted to the Commonwealth Games Council for Wales's selection committee:

- The number and quality of Minimum Consideration Scores (MCS) achieved since the start of the cycle i.e. January 2012
  - Weighting will apply to those scores achieved on
    - Single diagram paper or electronic scoring systems
    - UK based or 'abroad' International / quality matches
- Proven 'on form' quantity and quality of MCS results in matches in the final 12 months leading up to nomination.
- All matches in which the prospective nominee participates will be open or international events. These events will have readily available and published results, copies of which will be submitted with MCS's to the WSRA Secretary. Scoring will have been carried out by independent scorers appointed by the event organising committee.
- Nominees must be full members of WSRA and NSRA for the term of the process
- All equipment will conform to current ISSF regulations
- Athletes will conform to IOC drug regulations

The following will NOT be taken into account or given any consideration when assessing nominees for submission:

- Closed, club 'member only' shoots
- Re-entry, postal league competitions or part matches
- Scores achieved in training - live-fire or electronic targetry
- Indoor competitions
- Scores achieved at any distance other than 50m

Prospective nominees will be required to register their intent to compete for nomination in writing to the WSRA Secretary complete with a commitment fee of £25. This fee is to establish a firm commitment from individuals and to cover administration of MCS collation, communication and the final nomination process. Individuals who are successful and go on to compete at the Games will be refunded their commitment fee.

**Registration and fee are to be submitted by**

**31<sup>st</sup> March 2012**

Decisions on any late 'Nominee Commitment' submissions will be taken by the WSRA Committee and their decision will be final after all circumstances have been taken into account;

**there will be no appeal.**

Those members thus committed to the process will in due course receive copies of the expected MCS's (when established by CGW) and the revised WSRA / WTSF nomination rules and regulations. Submitted scores will be published with WSRA Committee Meeting Minutes and it is up to the individual athlete to ensure results are forwarded; no submission will result in scores not being included in the nominee table.
