

NEW POSTAL COMPETITION FOR 2012

LIGHTWEIGHT SPORT RIFLE INDIVIDUAL LEAGUE (Comp. 353)



Following a suggestion to the Shooting Council, the Technical Committees have agreed to run an individual league on a trial basis.

The course of fire will be Lightweight Sport Rifle Standing Any Sights and participation in it will enable those competitors to be included in the RWS National Ranking, as published annually in *The Rifleman*, which was previously limited to those who shoot in the Club Team League (Summer season).

The league will run to the same timescale as the LSR Standing Any Sights Team League (Comp. 150).

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1. Entrants must be an NSRA Life, Annual or Associate member.
2. Shooters who are members of club teams originally declared for Comp. 150 are **not** eligible to enter the Individual League, but anyone declared as a reserve at the time of the team entry may enter.
3. Participation in the Individual League will not preclude a shooter being used as a reserve for a team member in Comp. 150 after the start of the competition.
4. Cards shot as a reserve in a club team may not be fired concurrently with cards in the Individual League.
5. Course of fire – 20 shots per round at 20 yards or 25 metres.
6. Targets – PL14 at 20 yards; SPA1 or PL19 at 25 metres.
7. Inclusion in the National Ranking will be based on performance in the Individual League and will not take account of any cards shot as a reserve in the Team League. To be included in the Ranking a shooter must have shot all the rounds of the league and had no cards disallowed or unscored.
8. Entry fee - £6.75.

ELIGIBILITY

Entry is restricted to Life, Annual & Associate Members of the NSRA.

CALCULATION OF AVERAGES

Averages shall be given as points scored, not dropped, and must be quoted to one decimal place and not be rounded to the nearest whole number. They must be calculated as the best five of the last six courses of fire specific to the competition entered, fired on the shooter's home range and must be certified as correct on the entry form by the Club Secretary, Captain or other appropriate club official.

If you are unable to declare an average in accordance with the relevant conditions for a competition, an explanation of the cards used to obtain the average declared must be sent with the entry.

Please send a S.A.E. if you require acknowledgement of entry.
